Key Questions and Golden Nuggets

What is incarnation?

Christians believe that Jesus is God and that God put on skin and was born as a baby in Bethlehem. This is called incarnation.

Where does 'Incarnation' fit into the Big Story of the Bible?

See Big Story of the Bible. God's people still aren't doing the right thing so God comes as Jesus to make it better for them. God becomes a person!

What happens in the Nativity and what does this leach Christians about who Jesus is?

First, the Angel Gabriel visited Mary to tell she would have a special baby. Then, Mary and Joseph went on a journey to Bethlehem. After that, Jesus was born and placed in a manger. A little later, angels visited shepherds in the fields to tell them the good news. Then, the shepherds went to visit the baby. Much later, Wise Men followed a star to find Jesus. Christians believe that Jesus is God born as a human and that he was both fully God and fully human.

Why do Christians have Nativity scenes and what do they show us?

Nativity scenes help Christians to celebrate God becoming a person and being born as baby Jesus. Nativity scenes show the lowly conditions Jesus was born in and remind Christians of the different people who thought Jesus was important enough to come to visit.

What lessons might Christians learn from the Christmas story?

The Christmas story shows Christians how God gave up everything to be born in a lowly stable. It leaches Christians the importance of being generous to others. It reminds Christians that Jesus came to love both rich people like the Wise Men and poor people like the shepherds.

Big Story of the Bible

Creation



God creates the world in 6 days and then on Day 7 he has a rest. God says that his world is 'good'.

The Fall



Adam and Eve don't follow God's rules and they spoil their friendship with God.

Kings



God's people aren't very happy and ask for a King like the other countries. God lets them have a king.

Prophets



God wants to fix his friendship with humans so he asks prophets to tell the people and the King the right thing to do.

Incarnation



God's people still aren't doing the right thing so God comes as Jesus to make it better for them. God becomes a person!

Salvation



Jesus dies on the cross as a punishment for everything his people do wrong. His people can be friends with God again.

Kingdom of God



After Jesus goes to heaven, his friends and followers tell the world about the Good News of Jesus.

New creation



Christians believe that Jesus will come again and bring a new heaven and earth where everything will be per fect again.

Old Testament




